DAY 1



Fly from Stanstead to Lamezia and then by coach to Castrovillari, which is near the Pollino National Park

After check-in guests will be invited to a welcome cocktail.

In the evening dinner will be at a local restaurant in the heart of the old city.

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DAY 2

FERROCINTO® VINI E SPUMANZI DEL POLLINO

After breakfast at the resort, you will travel by coach to IL CASTELLO DI FERROCINTO AZIENDA AGRICOLA AGRITURISTICA.

The estate is located in the territory of Castrovillari, in the area of the "Vineyards", named because of the natural vocation of the territory.

This is an impressive complex of about 123 hectares of vineyards and olive groves, a real paradise for Magliocco, Montonico, Aglianico, Cabernet Sauvignon and Chardonnay vines.

This is a family run estate combining traditional agricultural methods with modern and environmentally friendly technologies, with the goal of making the wine an ambassador for the region.

Dinner will be in a restaurant in the City.

DAY 3



On day 3 we are visiting the Antichevigne winery in the Savuto valley. This is said to be the home of the 'oldest grape varieties in the world' including Greco, Arvino, Pecorello, Mantónico and Malvasia.

The vineyards are located between various villages in the valley. The villages are 500m to 800m above sea level. The soil is a sandy loam sloping at angles of 10% - 35% giving the grapes a unique flavour created by the soil, the altitude, and the exposure to the elements.

The wine tour is across four vineyards each with different characteristics. It starts at Vigna Carita which is 500m above sea level and progress to Vigna Britto, Vigna Colle Pieta (800m above sea level) and finally Vigna Vaschi in the District of Grimaldi.

DAY 4



Senatore Vini started at the beginning of the 20th Century and its progression is truly 'A FAMILY STORY' Generations of the Senatore family have been involved in the business. But it was in the 1930's that the current vineyards were planted.

The vineyard is at the heart of Ciro, nestled between the sun kissed hills and the sea making it a perfect location for wine production.

Sustainability is at the centre of the family's ethos and their wine has officially been accredited organic since 2017.

The wine tour lasts approximately 2 hours and in addition there is an opportunity to visit the village of Ciro, with its museum, bastion and castle.

DAY 5



“TENUTE IUZZULINI” THE AROMA OF WINEYARDS AND BREEZE OF THE WAVES.

Cirò Marina is a place, known throughout the world for wine production. It was named "Enotria" by the Greek colonists precisely by virtue of the favorable conditions for the cultivation of vines.

The estate covers an area of approximately 500 hectares of which 100 hectares of specialized vineyards, 50 hectares of centuries-old olive groves, 100 hectares of arable land and the remaining part made up of pastures and woods for livestock.

Tenuta Iuzzolino has a museum located in its wine cellar dedicated to the ancient crafts of wine making which is part of the tour.

DAY 6



A coach will take you back to Lamezia Airport according to the time of the flight.

Pricing is seasonal in the region of £1,400 - £1,600 per person.

Low Season is April - May and September - October. High Season is June to August.

Average Temperature is 25 - 35 °C depending on season.

The price includes flights, accommodation, transportation during the trip, breakfast at the hotel and evening meal at selected restaurants. It also includes the cost of the wine experience at each vineyard.
